

Technovation 2017 Student Ambassador Program Application

Overview

Technovation is a program that is deeply committed to engaging young women in STEM & Computer Science learning and helping them to become creative problem solvers in their communities.

We are interested in engaging and supporting our student alumnae to become Technovation Ambassadors and leaders in their communities. If you are an alumna, we're excited to help you step into your next big role in the Technovation community and invite you to apply to the **2017 Student Ambassador program!**

Through this program, Technovation Student Ambassadors will:

- Learn how to become effective Ambassadors through formal training and ongoing support from the Technovation team
- Receive guidance on creating and executing action plans to engage new students in underserved communities
- Be profiled and recognized on the Technovation Student Ambassador website
- Be eligible to apply for a second year of engagement resulting in internship opportunities and further leadership opportunities (such as training the next cohort of Technovation Student Ambassadors)

Eligibility & Expectations

To be eligible, you must have taken part as a student in the Technovation Program between 2010-2017, be between the ages of 14-21 at the time of application, and identify as female. Please note that if you are accepted, you will be expected to undertake a virtual training with the 2017 Student Ambassador cohort in September 2017, be committed to the above program components and dates, and potentially attend an in-person conference the following summer (2018).

Important Dates & Program Components:

March 10, 2017: Applications Open

April 10, 2017: Application Submission Deadline

April 11-May 9, 2017: Technovation Internal Review & Ambassador Interview Period

May 10, 2017: Public Announcement of 2017 Student Ambassadors

September 2017: 2017 Student Ambassadors Virtual Cohort Training

Fall 2017 - Spring 2018: Student Ambassadors will participate in:

- Attending monthly Student Ambassador meetings
- Implementing Technovation local recruitment action plans
- Engaging and supporting local teams by leading Technovation Launch Workshops
- Responding to team questions during the season
- Assisting with regional or local Technovation Pitch Events

These Student Ambassador activities will be supported by and planned in conjunction with a Technovation Regional Ambassador who will mentor the Student Ambassador throughout the duration of the Technovation season.
